## About the position

- Writing scripts/summaries and interview questions for our podcasts
- General work regarding the podcasts i.e. reaching out to guests and help to produce the podcasts
- Internal coordination in an organization

- Updating Digi-Talks social media when new content is posted

## What do we expect?

The event committee is in the planning phase all year around, which makes it important that you are able to meet for 17:00-19:00 each monday, and furthermore participate in various events throughout the semester. We expect you to be a team player, and that you set aside an average of 3-5 hours per week for your efforts, although it fluctuates greatly. We expect that you can volunteer for a minimum of half year and that you are a student at a Danish university in the greater Copenhagen area.
