About the position

As a volunteer accountant at Digi-Talks, you have the opportunity to organize and handle the spending and budget for one of the most admired student organizations in Denmark. You will be in charge of managing the financial sponsorship from Ørsted as well as the bookkeeping for our spending and the yearly financial reports. You will also be part of our board consisting of 4 members from Digi-Talks, which among other things include participating in meetings with our Advisory Board. In Digi-Talks, you will be a part of a big team, where Solidarity, Responsibility and creativity are the embodiment of our organisation. You will become part of a social and committed group of student, who are looking forward to working alongside you.

You will gain experience with a number of different tasks, including:

- Bookkeeping
- Budgeting
- Internal coordination in an organization
- Creating financial reports annually
- Working in a board

What do we expect?

The event committee is in the planning phase all year around, which makes it important that you are able to meet for 17:00-19:00 each monday, and furthermore participate in various events throughout the semester. We expect you to be a team player, and that you set aside an average of 3-5 hours per week for your efforts, although it fluctuates greatly. We expect that you can volunteer for a minimum of half year and that you are a student at a Danish university in the greater Copenhagen area.

A chance to work with one of the biggest and most coveted student organisations. Practical work that will allow you to practise your skills in bookkeeping and accounting. An opportunity to network with some of the biggest actors in the danish tech industry.
